New Feature Information for Catalogic DPX 4.5.4

Feature	Description	Benefit
Agentless Backup Support		
Archive support for Agentless backups to vStor target	Host-to-vStor-to-media archiving is supported for Agentless backups. During a recovery job, if backups from vStor are unavailable, recovery proceeds automatically from archive media. This feature complements archive support for agent-based block backups released in DPX 4.5.3.	Allows vStor-hosted backups to be archived to tape or VTL for long term retention. Provides an alternate recovery route if backups are unavailable on vStor storage.
Bare Metal Recovery Enhancements		
Windows BMR Support for vStor	Bare Metal Recovery is available for Window Block backups to the vStor appliance.	Provides for recovery of physical Windows servers on new or different hardware.
Linux BMR Support for vStor	Bare Metal Recovery is available for Linux Block backups to the vStor appliance. Linux client nodes require kernel 3.10 or later.	Provides for recovery of physical Linux servers on new or different hardware.
Virtualization Enhancements		
vSphere 6.7 Support	VMware vSphere 6.7 is supported with virtualized features for both Block and Agentless backups.	Extends virtualization support to latest vSphere release.
